

Government schemes for disabled persons in India include the [ADIP Scheme](#) for procuring assistive devices, the [Indira Gandhi National Disability Pension Scheme](#) for monthly financial assistance to the poor, and programs by the [National Divyangjan Finance and Development Corporation \(NDFDC\)](#) like the [Divyangjan Swavalamban Yojana](#) for income generation. Other initiatives include educational support and schemes for specific aids and appliances, aiming to promote physical, social, and economic rehabilitation for individuals with disabilities.

Financial & Livelihood Schemes

- [Indira Gandhi National Disability Pension Scheme \(IGNDPS\)](#):

A monthly pension is provided to disabled individuals below the poverty line, with contributions from both the central and state governments.

- [Divyangjan Swavalamban Yojana](#):

This NDFDC scheme offers concessional loans for income-generating activities to help persons with disabilities become self-reliant, as noted by the [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities \(DEPwD\)](#).

- [Vishesh Microfinance Yojana \(VMY\)](#):

NDFDC also provides need-based microfinance at reasonable interest rates to help target groups and individuals pursue small business and development activities.



Assistive Devices & Rehabilitation

- [Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase / Fitting of Aids and Appliances \(ADIP Scheme\)](#):

This long-standing scheme aims to provide durable and modern aids and appliances to persons with disabilities to improve their physical, social, and psychological rehabilitation, according to the [Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities \(DEPwD\)](#).

- Motorized Tricycles and Wheelchairs:

Subsidies are provided for motorized wheelchairs and tricycles to eligible individuals with severe mobility impairments, with limitations for those with mental impairments.

Educational & Skill Development

- [National Fund for PwDs](#):

The fund offers scholarships and tuition fee reimbursement to disabled students, including those pursuing STEM subjects from classes 9 to 12.

- [Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme \(DDRS\)](#):

This scheme encourages voluntary action and supports projects for the welfare of persons with disabilities, as per the [National Portal of India](#).






Human Story

A freak accident turned life upside down .But the will and determination and a planned path to recovery and life turned it all

Year **2017** a normal day goes to college by train .Unfortunately slips and falls on the platform and his legs get stuck between the train and the platform .Gruesome injury to his right leg and his knee cap on the left also gets badly damaged .

Though immediately admitted to the hospital and operated upon his right leg could not be saved .They had to operate on the same and amputate the same below his knee . The left was also operated upon to set right his knee cap .Though not fully cured they could salvage his left leg .

He was fully immobilised for about 6 months and was advised bed rest



